



# Seven Day Prayer Guide

## SUNDAY

- 1. Our nation, that as a people we will call out to God in humility, repent of our sins, seek to obey Him, and become a righteous people. Righteousness exalts a nation ... [Proverbs 14:34].
- 2. Our families, that they will be intact and strong for the raising of Godly children for the growth of the church and Christ's kingdom.
- 3. Our churches, that they, among others things, will be effective in making disciples who become the preservers and illuminators of the Truth.
- 4. The RNHA organization, that it will continue to positively affect our country as it holds true to its values of
- 5. God, Family, and Country. Protection from enemies without and within that are attempting to bring down our great country.

## MONDAY

- 1. President Trump and VP Pence, that God will provide them and their families Devine protection and good health.
- 2. That God will give them an abundance wisdom, humility, discernment, obedience to Truth, tenacity, and courage.
- 3. All Cabinet members and advisors of the POTUS and VP, that they will be discerning of the Truth, be effective in their jobs, and give wise advice and counsel to the POTUS/VP.
- 4. Our law enforcement officers, that God will protect them, and that we will appreciate and support them, as they risk their lives daily to protect us.
- 5. All good candidates for elected office, that we will recognize them as the best choice for our vote based on their character, their history of accomplishments, promises kept, and the platform they represent (is it more in line with God's Word than the opposition platform?).

## TUESDAY

- 1. All U.S. Senators and Congressmen and Congresswomen, that they will make wise and courageous decisions for the true betterment of America (and not use their political power for personal gain), especially during this critical time in our nation's history.
- 2. Judges at all levels, that they will follow the U.S. Constitution (and their state constitutions and statutory law) in their rulings and not legislate from the bench — and not let the belief in stare decisis prevent bad rulings (i.e., rulings not accurately grounded in the text of the Constitution) from being overturned.
- 3. All state and local leaders, that they will make wise and courageous decisions based on the rule of law — and that they will not bow to intimidation from radical activists that are destroying our cities and so many people's lives.
- 4. A thankful heart for the heritage of our wise and god-fearing founders and the founding principles they gave us.

## WEDNESDAY

- 1. Church and parachurch leaders, that God will give them extra boldness during this election season to speak truth about party platforms and candidates and to not let the label of "politics" intimidate them from speaking on issues that God calls sin.
- 2. Christian seminary and college leaders/professors, and others in educational vocations, that they may not shy away from teaching politics (because it's "dirty"), but teach it gently but boldly from a Christian worldview perspective.
- 3. Primary and secondary educators (public, private, and home-school), administrators, school boards and teachers unions, that they would set moral guidelines and teach our children correctly based on an accurate portrayal of history and morality that can only be truly grounded in the Word of God.
- 4. Discernment in understanding the correct Biblical view of Capitalism vs. Socialism.
- 5. Discernment in separating truth from gaslighting and outright lies (e.g., the violent riots in many American cities are just "peaceful protests") "The Lord detests lying lips, but he delights in people who are trustworthy." Proverbs 12:22

## THURSDAY

- 1. Our election integrity, that those who try to commit voter fraud or confusion, by whatever means, will be thwarted.
- 2. Our freedom of religion and speech and our ability to obtain information without censorship, will not be restricted.
- 3. Our news media, that those who give us accurate and unbiased news will be rewarded with large viewing audiences, and those who try to mislead or deceive the public (whether by acts of commission or omission) will be exposed and lose viewers.
- 4. Diligence in seeking a correct understanding of climate change, why there is such a polarization of views on its causes, severity, and corrective solutions, and the consequences/costs of implementing proposals such as the Green New Deal.
- 5. Wise decision making by our political/medical leaders/experts regarding COVID-19 that are based on facts and not any hidden/self-serving agendas. Pray for the safety of our people and the health of our economy and society.

## FRIDAY

- 1. Our volunteer prayer leader(s) at today's prayer meeting, that their words may magnify the Name of our Holy God and stir us to prayer and action.
- 2. All prayer meeting participants, that their hearts may be open to the Truth and that they may be stirred to fervent prayer and action.
- 3. Our volunteer prayer leader(s) at today's prayer meeting, that we may lift up thanks to God for them for volunteering their time (some are not even part of the RNHA family yet they agreed to pray with and for us).
- 4. A Trump ticket victory this November (including up and down the ballot wins) based on an agenda and platform more closely aligned with scriptural principles than those of the opposition. ## SATURDAY

- 3. Diligence in seeking a correct Biblical understanding of racism (read: <https://ses.edu/racism/>), it's history including efforts our country has taken to address this sin, the BLM movement and its stated goals, and the desire to reach agreement that All Human Lives are Sacred.
- 4. God's restraint on the rapidly growing mainstreaming of irrationality (madness actually) — especially as it relates to the rejection of the gender binary reality (Genesis 5:2) — with its attendant negative individual and societal consequences.
- 5. A move of the Holy Spirit throughout our land in revival that many will be convicted in their hearts of sin and cry out for forgiveness and redemption that God will freely give to all who ask.
